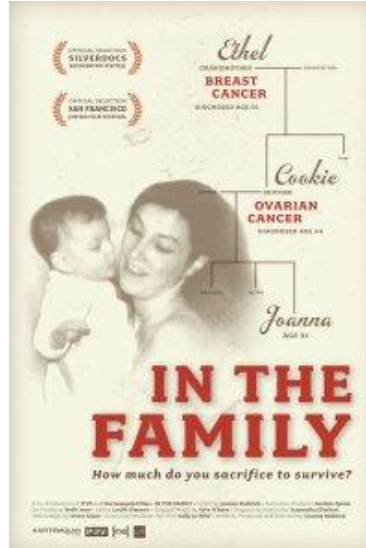




# In Honor of National Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer Week: Screening of the Award-Winning Documentary

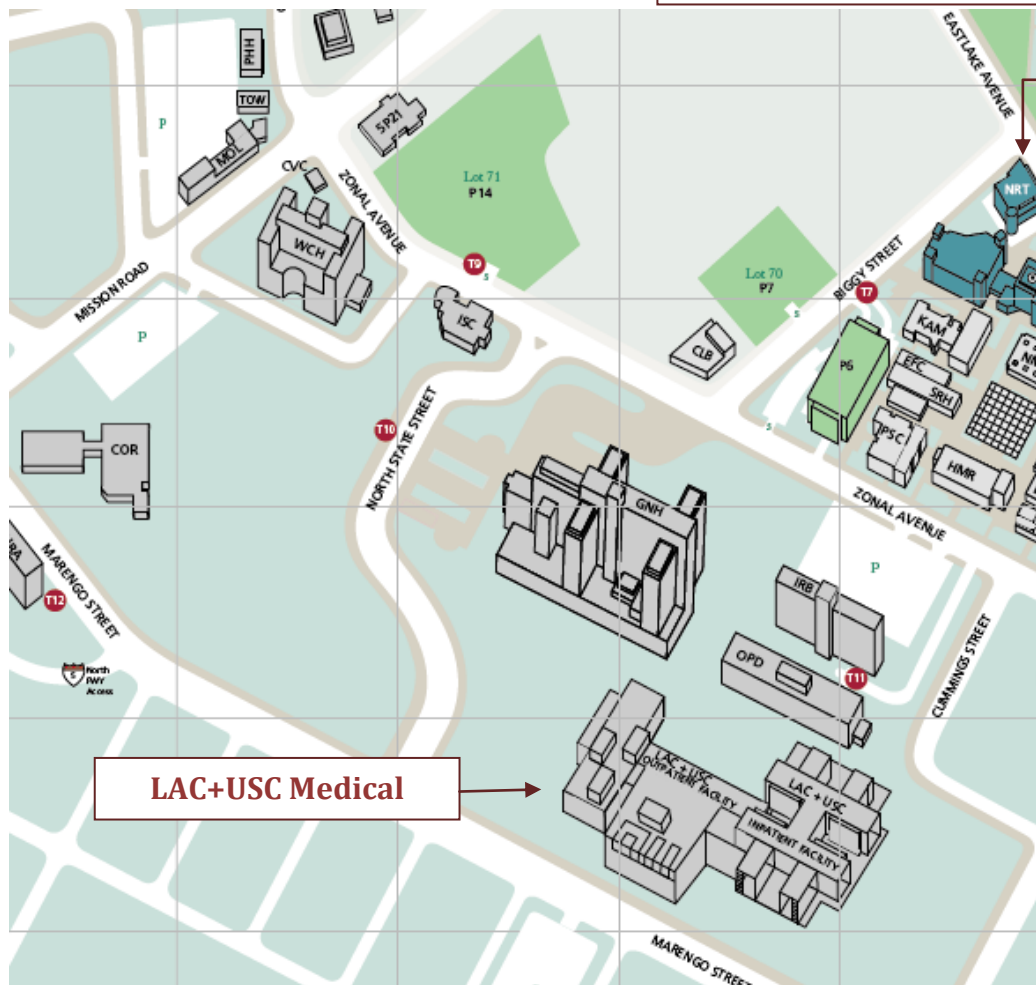
